

LOCATION

Parents and their children study in the same locations. The summer programme takes place in our Belgravia school, near Victoria station. The winter, spring and autumn programmes take place in our Kensington school, opposite Gloucester Road station.



AGES

Children of ages 6-16 are accepted. A parent or guardian of a 6 year old must also take a programme or remain in the school during lesson times. The minimum age for adult in charge is 21.

PRIVATE LESSONS AND MINI GROUPS

TRINITY SPOKEN ENGLISH TEST
