The English & Sail Learn to Earn Course is designed for Working Holiday Visa holders, or students with an interest in Marine Tourism.

The English & Sail Learn to Earn is a practical programme of General Intensive English plus a 23 day Sail Learn to Earn Course.

Sail Learn to Earn teaches sailing and marine skills to prepare students for working onboard a sailing vessel in the Marine Tourism Industry.

On successful completion of the 23 day Sail Learn to Earn component of the course, students will receive:

- Commercial Crew Certificate
- Commercial Seatime Log Book
- Reference
- Interview for a position as ships crew onboard a working sailing vessel.

The Sail Learn to Earn Course is conducted on commercially surveyed yachts and meets the NSVC, National Standards for Commercial Vessels.

Students will complete their training onboard the sailing vessel.

In their spare time, students are able to explore the islands and snorkel the coral reefs of the Whitsundays.



ENGLISH LANGUAGE COURSE

Students complete a full-time English Language
Course (Monday to Friday, 25 hours per week) at
a level appropriate to their English language
proficiency level. The sailing component is
completed after the English Language Course.
The minimum English language Course length is 4
weeks, however, students will be pre-tested prior
to arrival to determine their English language
level and the number of weeks needed to meet
the English requirements of the 'Sail Learn to Earn'
Course.

SAIL LEARN TO EARN

This 23 Day Course includes a 5 day, 6 night Commercial Crew Course which will provide the skills to be an active crew member on a commercial yacht.

The course includes nautical knowledge, seamanship, rope work, boat handling, sail handling / setting, sailing knowledge, introductory engineering, introductory navigation, voyage planning, saftey equipment and introductory marine electronics.

After completion of the Commercial Crew
Course, students will complete practical training
as ships crew onboard commercial sailing vessels
for 12 nights - 2 nights at a time. During this time,
students will put into practice theory from the

Commerical Crew Course, practical learning about Charter Boat operations and assist the crew with guest services.



Students will be part of a working sailing vessel, and will be required to perform all duties onboard the yacht, including sailing, cleaning the yacht, food preparation, vessel turn-around and customer service.

Accommodation is provided when the student is not completing the practical component of the Sail Learn to Earn Course onboard the vessel.

COURSE ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

- Minimum English Proficiency: Completion of the SACE Intermediate level (IELTS 5.0).
- Students must be able to swim. (SACE can organise swimming lessons for students during their English course)

- English + Sail Learn to Earn Course commences on any Monday.
