





Academic summer programmes for students aged 15-17

The United Kingdom – 2019

If you're looking for a stimulating programme in the UK, and perhaps study there in the future, make sure you look at different parts of the country. KE's multi-centre programmes introduce bright and ambitious students to a range of options – as well as offering stimulating courses, presentations and activities.

Programmes run for: **three weeks** (with *three* separate, 1-week courses) or: two weeks (with two separate, 1-week courses)

For visits and certain events across the programme, we'll ask you to choose either:

- University focus: university study visits, plus preparation for university entry
- Discovery focus: city study visits, plus a look at the film, music and art of the UK

Courses (usually the same for both 'focuses', but each has a 'major' and a 'minor'): **Course A**

Major: Language or logic. Boost your reasoning and/or language skills: choose one of: Critical thinking
Academic language skills

Minor: Building confidence, speaking up! Whether shy or confident, you can improve... **Course B**

Major: Prepare for the future! Prepare for future study (IB/A-levels & beyond) and future life: choose one of: • Study skills • Research skills • The challenge of the future

Minor: Practical leadership and teamwork. Learn skills of leadership and cooperation. **Course C**

Major: Specialist (academic) subject course. For a great introduction to a possible area of study in the future: choose *one* of:

- Business and entrepreneurship
- Engineering and technology
- Law, society and international relations
- Medical sciences and psychology

Minor (University focus): presentations on: Choosing the right university; The personal statement; The interview – with practice on the statement and two 1-1 interviews *Minor (Discovery focus)*: a lively look at the film, music, art and pop culture of the UK

Programmes also include:

- Study visits to major cities, preceded by seminars
- Traditional afternoon tea and formal dinner with a seminar on dining & etiquette •
- Support from student mentors recruited from leading universities
- **News reviews and tutorials**
- Typically British sports and activities (with golf in Scotland)

Programmes are held on the campuses of leading universities:

CAMBRIDGE (St. Catharine's College); DURHAM (St. Chad's College); ST. ANDREWS (Wardlaw residence) If you choose the University focus, you'll also visit a selection of other leading universities, for example: King's College London; London School of Economics; University College London; Imperial College London; Sheffield; Leeds; York; Newcastle; Glasgow; Edinburgh; Aberdeen.

If you choose the Discovery focus, you'll go to world-famous places such as the British Museum, the National Gallery, the cities of Edinburgh and York.

And you'll all also enjoy: two full days in London with a boat trip; from St. Andrews: visit to the Scottish Highlands
