



# Academic summer programs for students aged 15-17

## USA and Canada - 2019

In the USA, KE's programs give you the chance to explore either the East (Boston and New York) or the West (San Francisco and Silicon Valley) – or a combination of these! In Canada, you focus on the great cities in the East (Montreal, Ottawa and Toronto). And all this as well as taking part in stimulating courses, seminars and activities.

**Programs** run for: **two weeks** (with *two* separate, 1-week courses)

or: **three weeks** (with *three* separate, 1-week courses)

For visits and certain events in the USA, we'll ask you to choose either:

- University focus: university study visits, plus preparation for university entry
- Discovery focus: city study visits, plus a look at the film, music and art of the USA

Courses (usually the same for both 'focuses', but each has a 'major' and a 'minor'):

### **Course A**

*Major: Language or logic*. Boost your reasoning and/or language skills: choose *one* of:

• Critical thinking • Preparation for ACT and SAT • Communication skills with TOEFL

Minor: Building confidence, speaking up! Whether shy or confident, you can improve...

#### **Course B**

**Major: Prepare for the future!** Prepare for future study (IB/A-levels & beyond) and future life: choose *one* of: • Study skills • Research skills • The challenge of the future

Minor: Practical leadership and teamwork. Learn skills of leadership and cooperation.

#### Course C

**Major: Specialist (academic) subject course.** For a great introduction to a possible area of study in the future: choose *one* of:

- Business and entrepreneurship
- Engineering and technology
- Law, society and international relations
- Medical sciences and psychology

Minor (University focus): presentations on: Choosing the right university; The personal essay;

The interview – with practice on the essay and two 1-1 interviews

Minor (Discovery focus - usa only): a lively look at the film, music, art and pop culture of the USA

If you choose the **University focus**, you'll also visit a selection of other leading universities, for example:

USA East: Harvard, MIT, Brown, Yale, Columbia, Amherst College

USA West: Stanford, UC Berkeley, UC Davis, San Francisco

Canada: McGill, Concordia, Ottawa, Carleton, Toronto, York, Waterloo, McMaster

If you choose the **Discovery focus** in the USA, you'll see more of world-famous places such as

USA East: Boston city, Central Park in NYC USA West: San Francisco

And you'll all also enjoy: USA East: ferry trip in New York; USA West: walk across the Golden Gate Bridge; visit to one or more

Silicon Valley companies; Canada: boat trip on Lake Ontario; visit to Niagara Falls

Dates: USA: between July 8 and 29, 2019; Canada: from July 22 to August 2, 2019 (see website for details)

Minimum English level required: B2 (CEF); IELTS 5.5; TOEFL iBT 80; FCE

Fees: USA: 2 weeks: USD\$4,750; 3 weeks: USD\$6,950; Canada: 11 days: CAD\$3,950

Fees include: programs as described; accommodation; two meals per day; travel and transfers (but not flights between East and

West in the USA); insurance
