Preparing an internationally recognised exam at Millfield

Our **IELTS preparation** is offered at our **Bruton Campus** and this is built into the flexible timetable. The positives with this being we can offer a good amount of IELTS Prep classes in the mornings and afternoons. This course **does not include the exam**.

Cambridge English is our **3 week program** that we have now moved to the **morning**. This allows students to choose a sport, academic or creative **option in the afternoon**.

Cambridge assessment English commonly asked questions

Last year it was an academy, this year can replace the general english - is that right? Yes for weeks 1-3 only. Students will need to attend for the full 3 weeks.

Are students still able to prepare for PET/FCE/CAE? Yes, we will run classes for each exam

Do you have the exam dates?

Preliminary B1 23rd July, Advanced C1 24th July, First B2 25th July. The speaking exams will take place during that week but we won't have the date until after the course starts.

How many students maximum per class? 12

How many english levels?

We will have 3 levels, so students prepare for the exam they are registered for. Cambridge requires us to register candidates before they arrive here so we will need to know which exam students wish to take when they register.

What level is required to do this course?

Students need to have studied at the level they wish to take before coming to Millfield and be aware of the exam tasks. Ideally they should have studied an exam preparation programme.

Is there an English test once I have booked on to this programme? Yes - there will be a test sent once students have registered. Students will need to complete this and will be given feedback with suggestions of work to do before they arrive with us.

English test the first day + test each new week? On the first day - they will take a practice paper for the exam they wish to do.
