Half day:


- Civita di Bagnoregio, where 2 earthquakes took place — see the ruins of the old city as well as the modern new city
- Bolsena: with a medieval fortress, a Renaissance palace and the *Miracle Chapel*
- Viterbo: also known as the *City of the Popes* and the *City of Thermal Baths*
- Romitori del Fiora: with rooms carved into the rock, made to host the hermits. Including a refreshing swim in the river!

Accommodation

- Students will reside in purpose-built 'cottages'. There are 2 twin bedded rooms per cottage, each with a bathroom (ratio 1 bathroom: 2 students). 2 cottages share a comfortable veranda with table and chairs
- All cottages are air conditioned. Boys and girls will be housed in separate cottages. Please note a deposit of 50 EURO per student is required on arrival, in case of damages. Towels are not included.

Meal plan

- Breakfast, lunch and dinner every day. Lunch and dinner are usually hot (with packed lunches on excursion days) and there is usually a choice of at least two main courses. We can cater for vegetarian and other dietary requirements on request.
- Bottled water is also supplied to students


