## WHAT HAPPENS IF A STUDENT CONTRACTS COVID-19?

We have a duty of care for all of our underage students. Unwell students will be placed in a single bedroom with their own bathroom and will be monitored regularly while following medical advice. Parents are welcome to ring the manager on site and ask for regular updates.

## WHAT ARE THE CURRENT RESTRICTIONS IN THE UK?

Regular testing has become the norm and the UK has been following a set programme where restrictions have been gradually eased. As of 21st June 2021, the government has announced there should be few restrictions in place.
