## **GCSE Summer Camp**

The GCSE Summer Camp programme is aimed at current year 10 students going into year 11 this September and combines catch-up revision in the core GCSE subjects of English, Maths and Science with a lively and engaging programme of team games and outdoor activities designed to bring the curriculum to life.

## **Accommodation**

#### Off-site residence (Charminster/Lulworth)

Both residences are located at a 20 minutes' walk from Summer Centre.

Accommodation is arranged in a mix of single and twin en-suite rooms.

Students are supervised by Kings residential wardens and internet access is available throughout the residence.
